INFORMATION REGARDING STANDING RULES, *Joy LeCuyer*

During the past few months, the board has been discussing Standing Rules. Organizations adopt standing rules to address routine administrative procedures. By putting them into writing, new directors and members can choose to maintain continuity or revise procedures. Standing rules may be adopted, amended or suspended by a majority vote of a quorum present at a meeting of the board or membership.

Although decisions have not yet been made about all of the proposed rules, the following have been adopted by the board:

Standing Rule #1 was adopted at the October 2020 meeting; it allows the board to conduct business on line with motions, discussion and voting. A vote to carry a motion must be unanimous if via email. Zoom meetings do not require unanimity; they are in-person meetings.

Standing Rule #2 directs the Recording Secretary to include in the minutes, the names of members who have accepted tasks, descriptions of the tasks accepted, along with deadlines and outcomes if applicable. The emailing of the minutes will serve as a reminder to those who have accepted responsibility for an action.

Standing Rule #3 The Santa Fe Woman's Club & Library Association will set aside 10 percent of its unrestricted net income annually to increase long-term savings.

Standing Rule #4 The President, Treasurer and Assistant Treasurer may authorize expenditures for building maintenance, supplies and emergency repairs to SFWC&LA property, with a limit of \$500 per incident.

We hope the membership will agree that these guidelines are helpful and will ratify the decision of the board at the Annual Meeting of the Santa Fe Woman's Club and Library Association on March 15, 2021.

PUMPKIN MUFFINS, *Betty Scott*

2 C white whole-wheat flour (I use whatever flour I have)
1 t baking soda
1 t baking powder
½ t salt
1 t cinnamon
½ t nutmeg
1/8 t cloves

1 ripe avocado – peeled, pitted and mashed
1 banana mashed
1 C pumpkin or sweet potato puree
2 eggs
¾ C sugar
1 t vanilla



Preheat oven to 350 degrees; put 12 cupcake wrappers in two muffin tins.
Mix dry ingredients with a whisk.

Wet Mix: avocado, banana, pumpkin or sweet potato, eggs, sugar and vanilla.
Combine dry ingredients with wet mix. Stir until smooth. Fill muffins tins evenly,
Add ½ pecan to the top of each and bake for 15-18 minutes.
