FRIENDS OF THE LIBRARY REPORT, *Joy LeCuyer, SFWC&LA Liaison*

The Friends of the Library Public Library Board of Directors met on Tuesday, April 27, 2021 via Google Meet. SFPL Director Maria Tucker reported that no date has been set for the reopening, but preparations are continuing, and a summer opening is possible. Staff vaccination status is good, outdoor and hybrid programs are planned, and the library is proceeding cautiously.

The Santa Fe Public Library is a recipient of a grant of \$15,000 to host the National Endowment for the Arts Big Read in the Santa Fe area. An Arts Endowment initiative in partnership with Arts Midwest, the NEA Big Read broadens our understanding of our world, our communities, and ourselves through the joy of sharing a good book. SFPL is one of 84 nonprofit organizations selected to receive an NEA Big Read grant to support a community reading program between September 2020 and June 2021. Plans are to hold this Big Read and its surrounding events/activities from March through June 2021. Community partners throughout Santa Fe will collaborate on the project.
