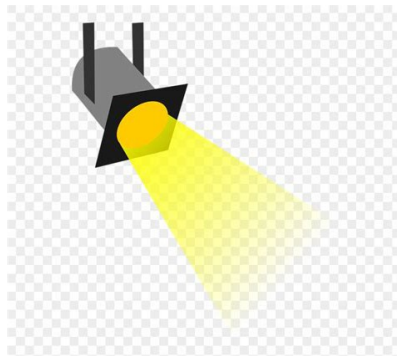

MEMBER SPOTLIGHT - MARS BERMAN

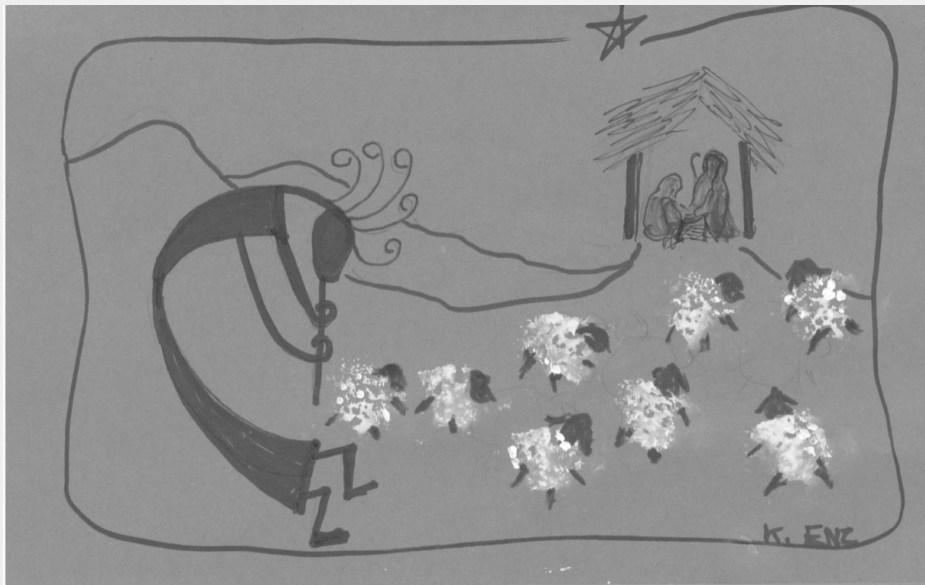

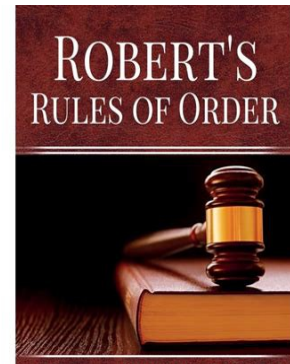

ROBERT'S RULES OF ORDER – HISTORY

The Santa Fe Woman's Club's meetings are conducted according to Robert's Rules of Order. But who was Robert? Henry Martin Robert, from Wisconsin, was a Captain during the Civil War. He was called on to chair a public meeting and found he needed something more than his sword to maintain decorum. After the war, he set about developing guidelines based on majority rule. His eventual book of Rules was published in 1875. The 4,000 copies sold quickly. Revised and expanded editions later sold in the millions. Robert retired as a brigadier general in 1901. He died in 1923.
