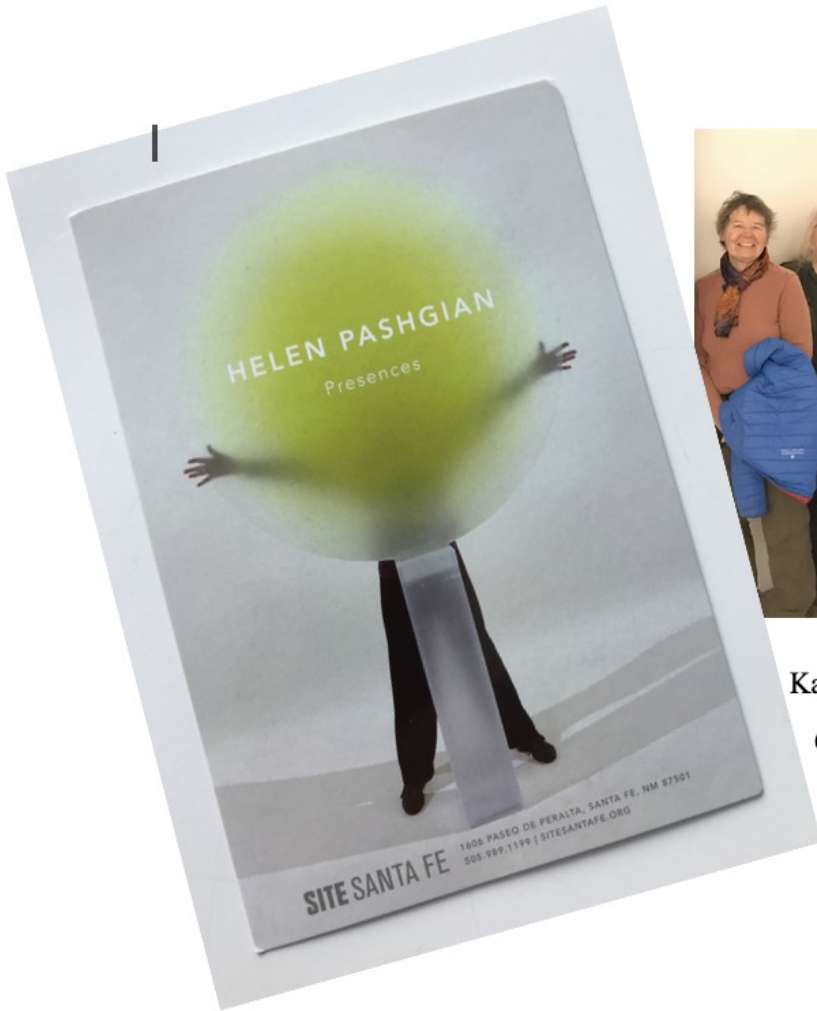

Standing Rules in Brief

Kinds of Rules Governing an Assembly from highest to lowest in authority

1. Law – rules prescribed by applicable law
2. Corporate Charter – (for incorporated groups)
3. Bylaws or Constitution – particular to the organization
4. Rules of Order – written rules of procedure
 - a) Special Rules of Order specific to the organization
 - b) Parliamentary Authority adopted by the membership
5. **Standing Rules – address administrative details**
6. Custom

Standing Rules are the rules of an organization that relate to administration and to some aspects of the conduct of meetings or sessions.

Unlike the Bylaws of an organization, Standing Rules are pretty flexible. They are easily adapted to the changing needs of an organization.

Standing Rules remain in force until repealed or annulled by majority vote. Standing rules may be changed or suspended by a majority vote if there has been notice to the membership, or without notice by a majority of the full membership, or 2/3 vote of those members present at a meeting.

Each member should have a copy of the rules.
